#### Who are we?

#### How do we collect information from you?

We obtain information about you either via relevant marketing events, our website or when you or someone from your organisation has contacted us about our products and services.



#### What type of information is collected from you?

The personal information we collect might include your name, address, email address, IP address, and information regarding which pages are accessed via marketing mailers or our website, and when. If you enquire about specific products or services we may retain this information too.

#### How is your information used?

We may use your information to:

- carry out our obligations arising before, during or after contracts entered into by you and us;
- seek your views or comments on the services we provide;
- notify you of changes to our services;
- send you communications which you have requested and/or that may be of interest to you. These may include information about free webinars, events, invitations, useful insights relating to our products and services
- send you communications relating to work we will be carrying out for you, are carrying out for you, or have carried out for you – this may include names and relevant contact details of people from your organisation as needed to carry out our contract obligations for you;
- process a grant or job application;
- issue administrative communications (invoices, purchase orders, order details, contracts)

We review our retention periods for personal information on a regular basis. We are legally required to hold some types of information to fulfil our statutory obligations. We will hold your personal information on our systems for as long as is necessary for the relevant activity, or as long as is set out in any relevant contract you hold with us.

When contacting you either by phone, email or post, we are doing so because we believe that you have a legitimate interest in our Performance Management solutions, events and insights within your business. From our research, or from information that you have provided, we have identified you as being the appropriate representative to address within the organisation. We have deemed this to represent legitimate interest in line with the ICO's guidance.



#### Who has access to your information?

We will not share, sell or rent your information to third parties.

**Third Party Service Providers working on our behalf:** We may pass your information to our third party service providers, agents subcontractors and other associated organisations for the purposes of completing tasks and providing services to you on our behalf (for example to follow up on communications we have commenced with you and send you mailings). However, when we use third party service providers, we disclose only the personal information that is necessary to deliver the service and we have a contract in place that requires them to keep your information secure and not to use it for their own direct marketing purposes. Please be reassured that we will not release your information to third parties, other than those working on our behalf, unless you have requested us to do so, or we are required to do so by law, for example, by a court order or for the purposes of prevention of fraud or other crime.

We may transfer your personal information to a third party in the following situations: i) as part of a sale of some or all of our business and assets to any third party ii) as part of any business restructuring or reorganisation, iii) if we're under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, iv) to enforce or apply our terms of use, v) to protect the rights, property or safety of our employees, associates and customers. However, we will take steps with the aim of ensuring that your privacy rights continue to be protected.

#### Your choices

You have a choice about whether or not you wish to receive information from us. If you do not want to receive direct marketing communications from us about our free events, sharing of best practice, or our products and services, then you can select your choices by unsubscribing at any time, or by contacting us directly by email or phone.

#### Use of 'cookies'
